getpid, getppid — get process identification

DESCRIPTION

Getpid returns the process ID of the current process. Most often it is used to generate uniquely-named temporary files.

Getppid returns the process ID of the parent of the current process. If the parent process has terminated, the current process has been inherited by the *init(VIII)* process.
